

**FEATURES:**

**Rework of the Event Filtering area and new “Diagnostic Events” panel:**

The event filtering panel has been revamped for improved usability, featuring both graphical and logical enhancements

- These updates allow for more intuitive searches and the ability to create more precise filters.
- As before, filter selections are saved locally on the device using uSee, so when the page is reloaded, the previously used filters will be retained

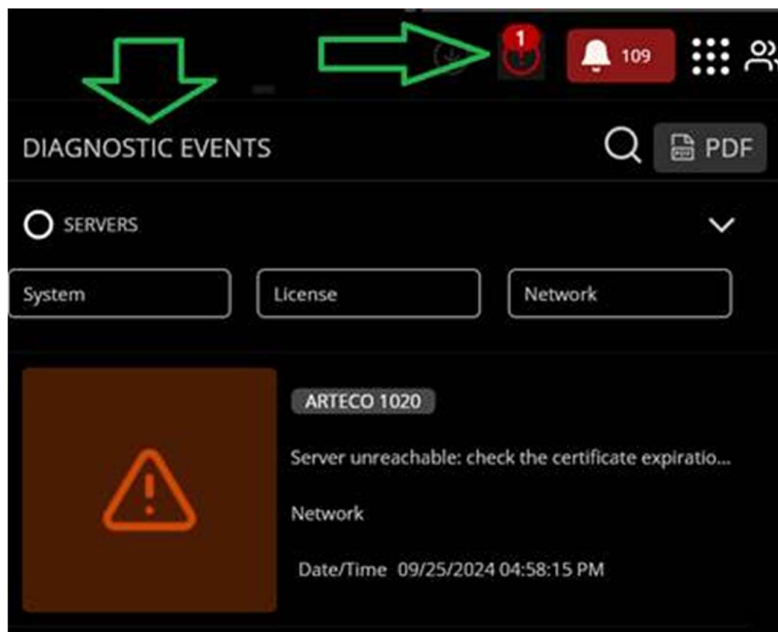
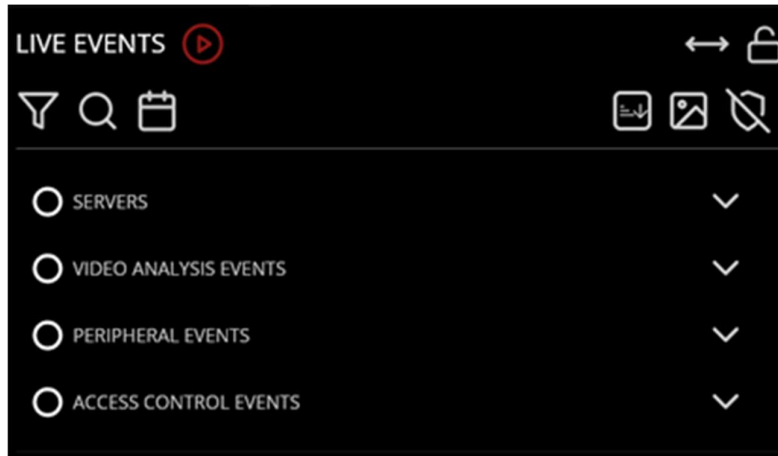
Additionally, a new panel displaying diagnostic events has been introduced.

**Important Notes:**

- These changes to the filters and the new diagnostic events panel are only available if you are logged into servers running Arteco-Server version 24.5 or higher. Otherwise, the old filtering system will remain, and the new diagnostic events panel will not be visible.
- To view the updated filters in uSee, you must clear your cookies and log in again.

**Steps to Delete Cookies for a Single Page in Google Chrome**

- Right-click the lock icon next to the URL in the address bar.
- Select “Cookies and site data” from the dropdown menu, then choose “Manage data and sites from your device.”
- In the pop-up window, find the list of cookies used by the site. You can remove them individually by selecting a cookie and clicking “Remove.”

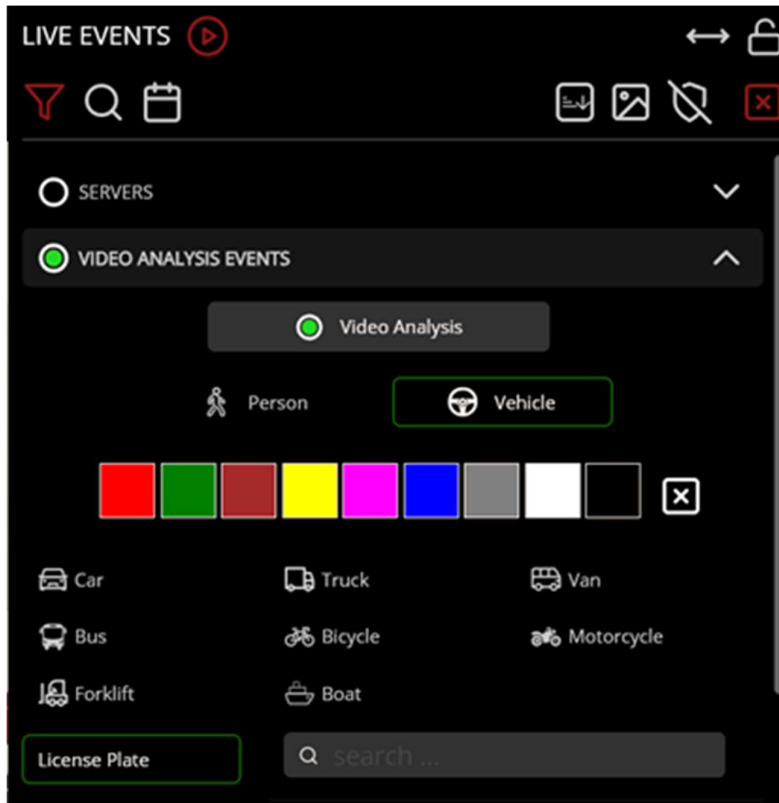
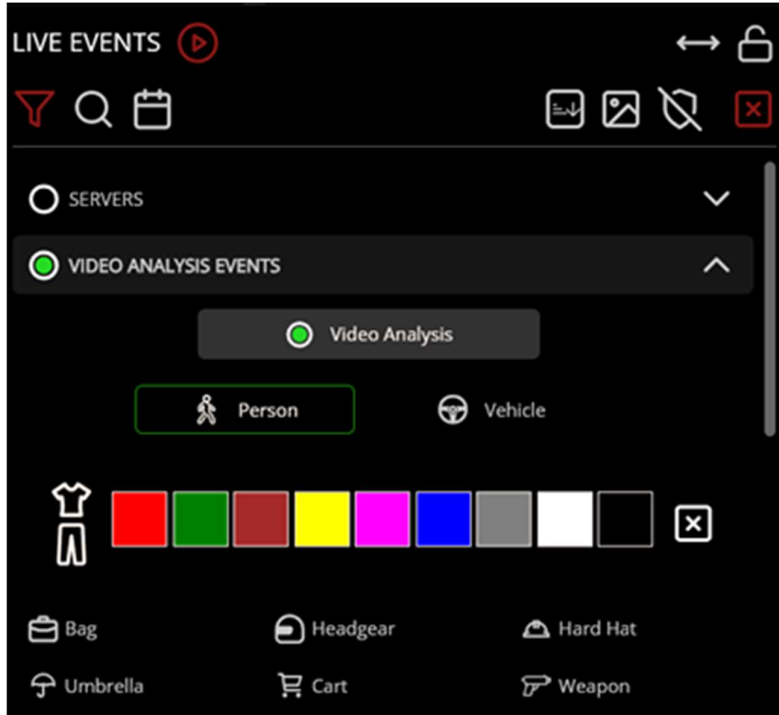


**Graphical Changes:**

- Significant graphical changes were made to the video analysis section, which is now divided into “Person” and “Vehicle”.
  - In the “Vehicle” section, a “License Plate” feature has been added to search for license plate readings which is not selected by default

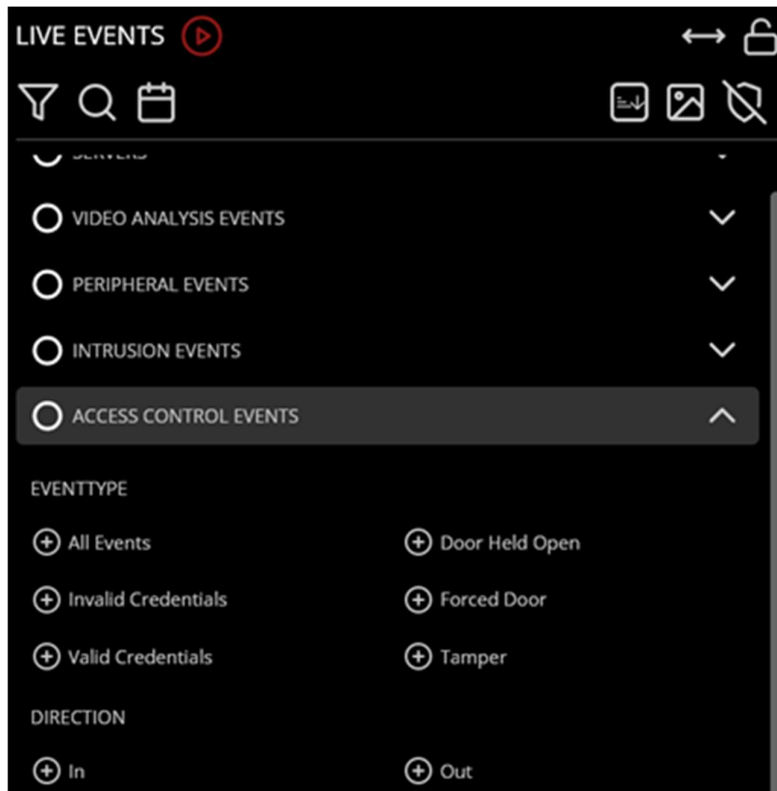

- A new section for “Access Control Events” has been added (e.g., for events from the “Impro” control panel).

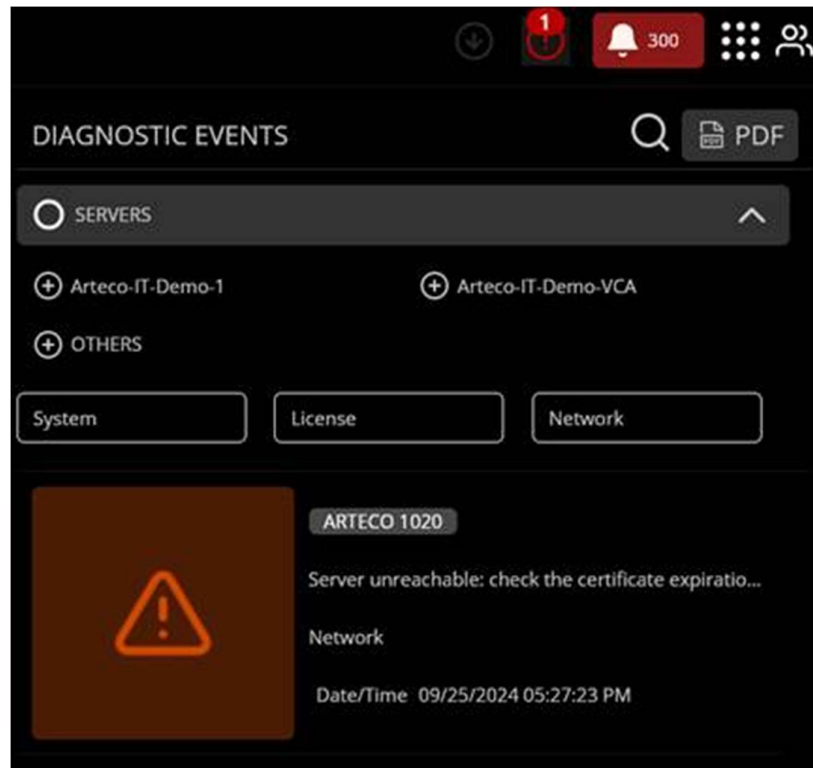

**Diagnostic Events Panel:**

- The “Diagnostic Events” panel displays a badge showing unopened or unviewed events. This counter decreases as events are viewed (i.e., when clicked).
- You can filter events by server or “OTHERS”. The “OTHERS” category includes events not recorded in the server DB but triggered by server actions (e.g., a failed login attempt).



**BUGFIXES:**

- Fixed an issue with the camera picker in the Thumbnail search.
- Fixed an issue where the MSE/MMS fallback live images would freeze when viewed for an extended period.
