The Event Panel has been restyled both in terms of graphics and functionality.

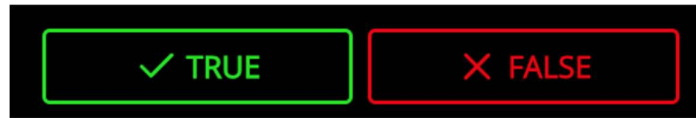



Ability to view events for the same device: Users can view the list of events associated with a specific device and access detailed information on each event with a single click.

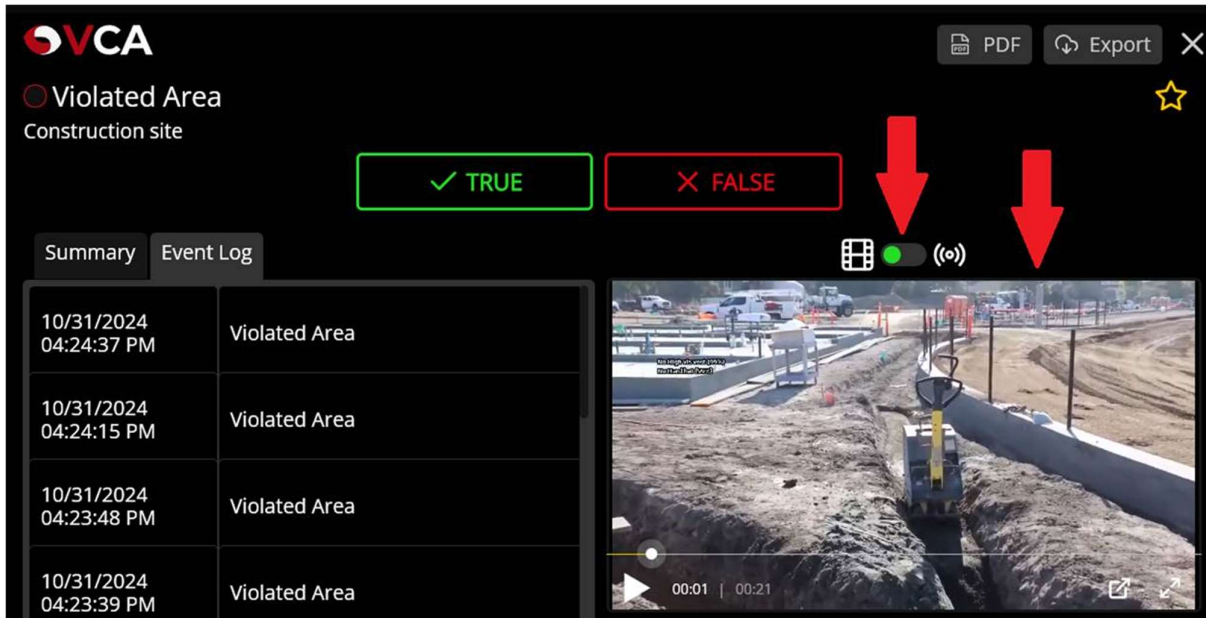
